

# **NEC SV8100 HANDSET USER GUIDE**

## **Making a Call**

- Lift Receiver or Press Speaker
- Dial the Required Number
- Converse

### NOTE:

For external calls, dial '0' first

### **Placing a Call on Hold**

With an external call in progress;

- Press the **Hold** key held key flashes
- You may replace the receiver if you wish

To retrieve the call;

- Lift receiver
- Press the flashing line key

#### NOTE:

For exclusive hold – press Feature then Hold

## **Transferring a Call**

With a call in progress:

- Press the **Transfer** key
- Dial an internal extension no. or an external number (enter '0' followed by number)
- Announce the call (optional)
- Replace receiver

### NOTE:

If the called extension is busy or does not answer, press the flashing **Line** key to return to your caller

## **Answering a Second Call**

With an external call in progress;

- Press the Hold key
- Then press flashing Line/Call key
- Converse

### **Last Number Redial**

Without lifting the receiver;

- Press the Redial button
- Use the cursor keys up/down to scroll through the last 10 dialed numbers
- Lift receiver or press Speaker to initiate the call

## **Microphone Control**

- A lit Mic LED indicates that your speaker microphone is on
- A unlit Mic LED indicates that you cannot respond to a caller when using the speakerphone (i.e. your voice is muted)

### **Mute Control**

With a call in progress (internal or external);

• Press the Mic key (the Mic key will flash)

### To un-mute

 Press the Mic key again (the Mic key will illuminate solid red)

## **Using System Speed Dials**

## Via Soft Keys:

Without lifting the receiver;

- Press the 'DIR' soft key
- Press the 'SPD' soft key
- Press the 'SYS' soft key
- Enter the letter you wish to begin your search with then use the cursor keys up/down to scroll through the speed dial entries
- Lift receiver or press **Speaker** to initiate the call

### Via Redial

Without lifting the receiver;

- Press the **Redial** button
- Enter the speed dial location number (i.e. 001 – 999)
- Lift receiver or press **Speaker** to initiate the call

## Call Pick Up

To answer an unknown ringing extension;

- Lift receiver
- Dial \* #
- Converse

To answer a known ringing extension;

- Lift receiver
- Dial \*\*
- Dial the ringing extension no.
- Converse

## **Incoming Call History**

Without lifting the receiver, press the **List** soft key

- Press CID soft key
- Use the cursor keys up/down to scroll through the last 50 received/missed callers
- Lift receiver or press Speaker to initiate the call

### NOTE:

A missed call is identified by a **'\*'** symbol before the date & time

# **Conference Calling**

With a call in progress (internal or external)

- Press Conf Kev
- Dial an internal or external number
- Upon answer, press the Add soft key

At this stage repeat points 2 & 3 to add further callers or proceed to the next step

Press the Begin soft key to initiate the conference call

### NOTE:

The amount of callers you can add into a conference call is dependent on the amount of lines your handset can handle.

Please note that this is a generic user guide and some features may not be available on your handset. Please speak to your phone system provider for further details.
